

Grand Junction Colo
June 11th 1887

Special meeting of the Board at the call of Mayor for the purpose of considering the title to certain lots and lands within the corporate limits of the town.

The following were present at roll call,
Mayor Rhone, Trustees Adams, Bliss, Crosby, Pardue Sharp and Whitehead.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution, with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea, Bliss yea Crosby yea, Pardue yea Sharp yea, Whitehead yea

Resolved that the Town Attorney be directed and authorized to institute suits against The Grand Junction Town and Improvement Company and George A Crawford and Henry B Parsons to set aside certain Deeds conveying to said parties certain lots, blocks and lands, and obtain title for the corporate authorities to such lots blocks and lands that are now claimed by said parties.

And said Attorney is authorized to employ such assistance as he may deem advisable subject to approval of the Board. Said suits being suits set forth in complaints heretofore read to the Board of Trustees.

Resolution declared adopted,
