

Grand Junction July 1st 1887

Regular meeting of the Board at the Council Room at 7<sup>30</sup> o'clock PM

Present at roll call Mayor Chone Trustees Adams, Crosby, Sharp, Whitehead, Cardue

Minutes of last regular meeting and Special meetings of June 4th and 11th read and approved.

The Board then considered the Bids for team works which were reconsidered at Special meeting of June 11th and the yeas and nays were called for on the acceptance of bid of W D Hammond at \$3 <sup>75</sup>/<sub>100</sub> he agreeing to furnish Scrapers and other necessary tools, with the following result Trustees voting were Adams yea, Crosby nay Cardue yea Sharp yea Whitehead yea. Bid declared accepted at \$3 <sup>75</sup>/<sub>100</sub> per day.

Report of Police Magistrate for month of June received and on motion accepted.

Also Report of Town Treas received and on motion referred to Finance Committee

Motion made and carried that when this Council adjourns it adjourns to meet at 7<sup>30</sup> o'clock PM tomorrow to meet a Sub Committee of Citizens to discuss the suits of The town of Grand Junction vs The Grand Junction Town & Dump Co and Geo A Crawford.
