The following Resolution of Citizens Committee by Benton Caion
Chairman was presented & ordered filed and on Motion laid on the

" To the citizens taxpayers of the town of Grand Junction,

We your Committee appointed to investigate fully the causes of the
present stagnation in all kinds of business and if possible
devise ways and means of reviving such stagnation, also to remove
if possible the apparent cloud of title to realty in our city
respectfully submit the following resolution for your approval
or disapproval.

Be it resolved: That it is the sense of
this Committee that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand
Junction should at once dismiss the several suits lately commenced
by the said town in the District Court of Mesa Co against
The Grand Junction Town & Improvement Co, Henry C Parsons
and George A Crawford, believing that the public interests
will be subserved by the dismissal of such suits without delay
