

Grand Junction July 18th 1889

Special meeting of the Board at 7³⁰ o'clock P.M.

Present at roll call J. I. Sharp acting Mayor, and
Trustees Pardin, Adams, Crosby.

The yeas and nays were called for on adoption of the following
Resolution with following result Trustees voting for were Adams yea
Crosby yea, Sharp yea Pardin yea.

Whereas it appearing to the Board of Trustees
of the Town of Grand Junction that the suits begun by the Board
to recover certain lots and lands within the corporate limits
of the town from Geo A Crawford and The Grand Junction Town
& Imp Co does not meet with the approval of the voters and
tax payers of the town, and Whereas it is the opinion of this
Board that the suits are just and should be decided by the Courts
and Whereas this Board regrets that they are compelled to
dismiss said suits believing that by doing so they violate their
oaths as Trustees, Therefore be it resolved That the Town Attorney
is hereby authorized instructed and it is made his duty to
dismiss said suits without prejudice,
