Board met in regular session at 7³⁰ o'clock PM

Present at Roll call Mayor Rhone. Trustees Adams, Crosby, Pardue, Sharp, Whitehead.

Minutes of last regular meeting and of special meetings July 12, 14, 16th, 17th and 18th read and approved

Petition for new sidewalk by Mrs Stille was presented and on motion referred to Committee on Sts & Alleys.

Petition of John Horton et al for sidewalk to extend from D&R R Depot on North side of South St to 3rd St. thence on West side of 3rd St to Colorado Avenue was presented and ordered filed.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following Resolution with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea. Crosby yea. Sharp yea. Pardue yea Whitehead yea. "Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of the following lots, along east side of lots 16 and 17 Block 1214 and east side of lots 16 & 17 Block 141 and east side of lots 16 & 17 Block 146 and along South side of lots 17 to 32 in Block 141 (inclusive) and along South side of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 142. and along South side of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 146. and along South side of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 145. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by ordinance except that it be four feet wide, be constructed along and in front of said lots under the provisions of Ordinances concerning sidewalks "

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following Resolution with the following result Trustees voting were Adams yea. Crosby yea. Pardue yea. Sharp yea Whitehead yea. "Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance except that it be four feet wide, be constructed along in front of lots 1 to 11 inclusive in Block 138 as per petition of Mrs Jennie Sumner. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance except it be four feet wide, be constructed along and in front of said lots under the provisions of Ordinances concerning sidewalks "

Report of Treas for July presented read and accepted
Report of Finance Com on Treas Report for June was received and on motion Report of Treas for June was accepted.

The Committee on Sts & Alleys made following report that they had conferred with the Board of Co Coms. in regard to the grading of the approach at South end of State Bridge. that they had agreed to appropriate the sum of \$200 and the Co Coms \$300 to grade same.

On motion the report was accepted,

The Resignation of C P Bliss as member of this Board which was laid over at previous meeting was on motion accepted,

Mr N J Krouse on behalf of the Grand Junction Water Co requested that he be granted the right to put up poles on 5th St from the Pump house to Main St for the exclusive use of the Water Co for the purpose of Telephone & fire alarm wires.

On motion his request was granted,

Motion made and carried that Wednesday Aug 7th at 1 o'clock P M be fixed as the time for making the test of the water works

Mr J M Jones and Mr David Roberts appeared before the Board as a Committee from the Board of Trade and requested that the Board appropriate \$2000 for the purpose of assisting in advertising the Town.

On motion the matter was referred to the Town Attorney with a request that he furnish the Board with a written opinion at next meeting.

Motion made and carried that the Town Engineer make a survey and estimate the amount of dirt to be removed for the purpose of grading the RR crossing on 5th St. and for the purpose of advertising for Bids for said work,

Motion made and carried that the St Com be instructed to ^{construct a cross} flume in the Mesa Co Ditch at 9th or 10th Streets,
