

Grand Junction Colo Sept 3rd 1887

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 7³⁰ o'clock P.M.

Present Mayor Phone Trustees Adams, Sharp
Crosby, Pardue and Whitehead,

The minutes of last regular meeting of Aug 5th and
special meeting of Aug 7th read and approved.

A petition signed by H.R. Bull et al for construction of
four foot sidewalk on East side of 4th St from Poole to Grand
Ave thence on South side of Grand Ave to 5th St was presented
read and the following resolution was adopted. The yeas and
nays being called for with the following result Trustees voting
for were Adams yea, Crosby yea, Pardue yea Sharp yea

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of
Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed
along and in front of the following lots to wit: along the West
side of lots 1 & 32 in Block 96 and along the West side of lots 1 &
32 in Block 81 and in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive of Block
81. Therefore be it ^{ordered} that a sidewalk such as provided by
Ordinance except it be four feet wide be constructed along and
in front of said lots under the provisions of Ordinances concerning
sidewalks.

The petition of Mrs Dora Steele for new sidewalk which
was referred to the Com on Streets & Alley's at last meeting
was taken up and the following resolution was adopted by
the Board. The yeas and nays being called for with the following
result Trustees voting for were Adams yea Pardue yea Crosby
yea Sharp yea.

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of
Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed
along the South side of Main St from 8th to 9th Streets.

Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided
by ordinance except it be four feet wide be constructed

along and in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive in Block 114 under the provisions of Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

A Petition was presented for the extension of 7th Street north to Corporate limits. On motion the same was referred to the Committee on Streets & Alleys.

Trustee Whitehead then appeared and took his seat.

The Board then proceeded to ballot for one Trustee to fill vacancy caused by resignation of C P Bliss.

W H Wolf having been placed in nomination received five votes. Trustees voting "for" were Adams, Crosby, Sharp, Pardue, Whitehead, and W H Wolf was declared elected Trustee.

The Report of Police Magistrate for month of August was received and on motion accepted.

Report of Treas for month of August was received and on motion referred to Finance Committee.

Motion made and carried that the Recorder issue a Duplicate for Warrant No 740 for \$77.50 upon said Bliss filing an indemnifying Bond for double the amount to J. Caswell Esq Agent for the Grand River Ditch Co was requested to submit a proposition at the next regular meeting to furnish water for the town for irrigating purposes for the term of ten years, an amount not exceeding 300 inches at \$2.75 per 100 inches and at same rate for less quantity than 300 inches.

Motion made and carried that the matter of platting Nobleys Addition be referred to the Com on Streets & Alleys and also that the Town Atty be requested to meet with said Committee.

On motion a permit was granted Mr Payne to repair his frame building on Main St.

Motion made and carried that when the Board adjourn it adjourn to meet Saturday Sep 7th at 7³⁰ o'clock PM.
