

Grand Junction Colo Sept 7th 1887

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 7<sup>30</sup> o'clock P.M.  
Present at roll call Mayor Rhone, Trustees Adams, Crosby  
Sharp, Pardue and Wolf.

Minutes of last regular meeting read and approved.

On motion the Mayor was instructed to sign the License of  
Farbell & Goff issued by City Clerk to retail liquors to Oct 1st 87.

The petition requesting the transfer of lots 27 to 32 Blk 81  
to Episcopal Church was on motion referred to Finance Committee

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of an  
Ordinance to amend Section 4 of Chapter 1st of article one (1) of  
the Revised Ordinances, concerning Licenses, with the following  
result Trustees voting were Adams yea Crosby yea, Pardue  
yea, Sharp yea, Wolf yea. The Ordinance was declared passed  
and adopted.

An Ordinance to amend article 3 of Chapter 5 of the Revised  
Ordinances, was read and the yeas and nays called for on its  
adoption with the following result Trustees <sup>voting</sup> were Adams yea  
Crosby yea, Pardue yea Sharp yea, Wolf yea. Said Ordinance  
was declared passed and adopted.

An Ordinance "Concerning Licenses" was read, and the yeas  
and nays called for on its adoption with the following result  
Trustees voting were Adams yea Crosby yea, Sharp yea, Pardue  
yea Wolf yea, and the Ordinance was declared passed and  
adopted as read.

Motion made and carried that a Committee on Fire be appointed.  
The Mayor then appointed as such Committee Trustees Wolf  
Adams and Pardue.

A certificate of the Town Engineer in relation to the test  
of the Waterworks had on the 7th day of Aug 1887 was  
presented and ordered filed.

The certificate of the Street Commissioner on the construction  
and cost of sidewalks in front of certain lots was presented  
read and approved and the cost of construction thereof ordered  
paid. The yeas and nays were then called for on the  
adoption of the following resolution with the following  
result Trustees voting were Adams yea Crosby yea  
Pardue yea, Sharp yea Wolf yea.

Resolved that a special tax be and is hereby assessed  
against the following lots and in the following amounts to wit

A special tax of \$7.50 against lot 25 in Block	118
" " " " 18.75 " " 23 " "	120
" " " " 18.75 " " 26 " "	120
" " " " 18.75 " " 29 " "	120
" " " " 18.75 " " 30 " "	120

All in the town of Grand Junction Mesa Co Colorado,  
 The said amounts respectively being the cost of constructing sidewalks  
 in front of said lots respectively. Said work having been done  
 in compliance with the orders of this Board and the Ordinance  
 in such case made and provided.

Motion made and carried that M Gramar act as  
 Marshal in the absence of Marshal Kennedy.
