

Grand Junction Colo Sept 15th 1889

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor Rhone, Trustees Adams, Sharp, Pardue  
Walf, Grosby and Whitehead.

The yeas and nays were called for on the motion to authorize  
the Cameron Hosiery Co No 1 to purchase 254 suits of clothes  
to cost a sum not exceeding Two hundred & fifty Dollars,  
with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea  
Grosby yea Pardue yea Walf yea, Sharp yea, Whitehead yea  
motion carried.

Bill of J G Crawford meals for Election Board & prisoners  
#6700 was allowed at \$5<sup>75</sup>/<sub>100</sub>.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption  
of the following Resolution with the following result. Trustees  
voting were Adams yea, Grosby yea, Pardue yea, Sharp yea  
Whitehead yea, Walf nay.

Resolved that in the opinion of the Board of Trustees  
of the town of Grand Junction, The Grand Junction Water Company  
being the assignees of N J Krusen and his associates have  
completed their system of water works in said town in  
accordance with their contract with the town and the ordinance  
passed November 23rd 1888, and a satisfactory test having  
been made Aug 7th 1889 the Mayor and Recorder are  
requested and instructed to endorse on the Bonds of the said  
Company the fact that said works have been so completed  
and tested. Resolution declared passed and adopted.
