

Grand Junction Colo Sept 30th 1887

Special meeting of the Board at the call of the Mayor for the purpose of receiving and considering Bonds for Retailing Regions in Grand Junction.

Present J. F. Sharp Mayor pro tem and Trustees Adams Wolf and Whitehead.

Motion made and carried that the Bonds as presented by the following named persons be approved, to wit; Gail C Murray Decher and Crosby, Leosgrove and Ryan, Geo W Thurston and Carbell and Hoff.

On motion the following Bills were allowed.

A P Cook Costs Case Town vs Town Co + G A Crawford #21 ⁵⁵/₁₀₀

It appearing to the Board it is necessary for the preservation of order that an Assistant Marshal be appointed therefore be it ordered that the Board proceed to elect an Assistant Marshal. Ballot being then taken with the following result, Geo Barr received four votes.

Trustees voting for were Adams, Sharp, Wolf and Whitehead. Geo Barr was declared elected Assistant Marshal.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution. Trustees voting were Adams yea Sharp yea, Wolf yea and Whitehead yea. Resolved that the Salary of the Assistant Marshal be fixed at \$75.00 per month.
