

Grand Junction Colo October 7th 1889

Regular meeting of the Board at the Council room at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Present Mayor Phone Trustees Adams, Crosby, Sharp, Purdue and Wolf.

Minutes of last regular and special meetings read and approved.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result, Trustees voting were Adams yea, Crosby yea Sharp yea Purdue yea, Wolf yea,

Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction Colorado, That for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said town for the fiscal year commencing April 1st 1889 there be levied, and collected on all taxable property within the limits of said town, the following taxes on each dollar of valuation of such property to wit:

For general purposes twelve (12) mills,
For the purpose of paying water rental for fire protection a special tax of three (3) mills,

The yeas and nays were called for on the motion to appropriate Five Hundred Dollars to assist the Fair Association with the following result Trustees voting Adams yea Crosby yea Sharp no Purdue yea Wolf yea, motion carried and the Recorder was ordered to draw a Warrant for the amount on the General fund.

A Committee on behalf of the County appeared and asked for a Deed to a portion of Block 84 known as Court House square. The City Atty was instructed to draw up a Deed for same in conjunction with the County Atty and submit the same to the Board at next meeting.

At the request of the Chairman of the Board of Co Commissioners Mr Howard was released on part of the town from his Contract with the County for grading approaches to State Bridge.

Board then adjourned to Oct 12th 7:30 o'clock P.M.
