

Grand Junction Colo
October 12th 1889

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present at roll call Mayor Rhone Trustees Adams
Crosby, Pardue and Sharp.

Bond of M Devereux to retail liquors in the town of
Grand Junction was presented and approved.

Petition of Geo W Hess and others for a new sidewalk to
be constructed in front of lots one to twelve in Block 99 and
lots one to sixteen in Block 98. and to be four feet wide, was
presented and the yeas and nays were called on the adoption of
the following resolution with the following result.

Trustees voting were Adams yea Crosby yea Pardue yea
Sharp yea.

Resolved that in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it
is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and
in front of lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 99 and lots 1 to
16 inclusive in Block 98. Therefore be it ordered that a
sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance except that it be
four feet wide be constructed along and in front of said lots
under the provisions of Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

Petition to grant Nishwitz and Heynes the privilege of keeping
a Saloon on lot 1 Block 119. signed by a majority of the lot
owners in said Block was presented and on motion the
petition was granted.

The application and Bond of Nishwitz and Heynes to retail
liquors in the town of Grand Junction was presented and on
motion approved.

Bond of Geo Barr as Assistant Marshal was presented
and approved.

The Contract for water for irrigation, between the Grand
River Detach Co and the town of Grand Junction was read
and referred to the Town Attorney.

And that a meeting of the Board of Trustees of said town will be held at the Council Room in the town of Grand Junction on Monday, the 6th day of May 1889 at half past seven o'clock PM when and where the owners of said lots may appear and be heard as to the justness and correctness of the amount so certified and assessed against said lots.

to make complaint, the assessments per lots heretofore made against each of said lots was on motion confirmed and the Recorder was instructed to certify said assessments to the County Clerk if not paid to him on or before the 28th day of Oct 1889.

On motion the Board designated the 4th day of November 1889 at 7³⁰ o'clock PM to hear and determine complaints as to the justness and correctness of the amount of tax certified and assessed against certain lots for the cost of constructing sidewalks. Said assessments having been made by the Board on the 7th day of Sept 1889.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result. Trustees voting were Adams yea Crosby yea Sharp yea Pardue yea
 Resolved that in the opinion of the Board no further necessity exists for a Street Commissioner. Therefore it is ordered that the services of Street Commissioner be dispensed with from this date and the Town Marshal is instructed and authorized to act in his stead.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to order from the North-Western Rubber Co of Chicago 750 feet of 2 1/2 inch Rubber Fire Hose. On motion the Marshal was authorized to construct a trough for draining the Fire Hose.

J T Sharp presented his resignation as member of this Board and on motion the same was accepted
