

Grand Junction Colo
Nov 1st 1887

Special meeting of the Board at the call of the Mayor for the purpose of amending an Ordinance concerning Licenses.

Present at roll Mayor Rhone and Trustees Adams, Crosby Wolf and Whitehead. Trustee Parden absent but had been notified of the meeting.

An Ordinance to amend an ordinance passed the 7th day of September 1887 concerning Licenses was read and the yeas and nays called for on its adoption with the following result, Trustees voting were Adams yea Crosby yea Wolf yea Whitehead yea. Ordinance as read declared passed and adopted.

On motion a Ballet was taken for Trustee to fill vacancy caused by the resignation of J. P. Sharp.

John Hynes received four votes and was declared elected a member of the Board of Trustees. Trustees voting for were Adams, Crosby, Wolf and Whitehead.

On motion The Mayor was authorized to appoint any number of Deputy Marshals for Election day which in his judgment would be necessary for the preservation of order.

On motion The Mayor was authorized to employ one or more men to work on the Streets and Ditches for the purpose of making needed repairs.

On motion Board then adjourned
