The committee appointed at last meeting to confer with
Water Company in reference to replacing the present
water pipe with Cast Iron pipe reported that they had
written to the Company in regard to the matter.

J. L. Nichols representing the owners of what is known
as the Keith Addition appeared before the Board and
asked the Board to order Crossings and Culverts put in on
a part of said Addition. On motion it was referred to the
committee on Streets and Alleys with power to act.

On motion Mr. Krusen Supt of Water Company was
given till Jan 1st 1890 to Report condition of works etc.

Motion made and carried that any material
or tools purchased hereafter must be on an order signed

by the Mayor,

On motion the Mayor was instructed to fully enforce the law in regard to contagious diseases

On motion the Board appointed M^r Fredericks, J^r O'David and Harry Crosby Special Police.

On motion the Mayor was instructed to demand the payment of the judgment against the County in the small pox case
