

Grand Junction Colo  
Jan 7<sup>th</sup> 1870

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

The meeting was called to order by H. R. Rhone in the Chair as Mayor, also present Adams, Crosby, Pardue, Walf, Hynes.

Minutes of last regular and special meetings of the Board read and approved.

On motion the Recorder was requested to procure the Ordinance Record for the purpose of having certain Ordinances signed.

Petitions for the construction of Sidewalks were presented and read as follows:

From South East corner of Block 79 to Gunnison Avenue on West side of 3rd St. Also from South West corner of Blk 106 on Main St to North Avenue along the East side of 7th St. Also from East side of 7th St to Keith Addition, on North side of Road St being in front of Blocks 92 & 93 and lots 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 & 32 Block 91. Also from Chipeta Ave to North Avenue on West side of 5th St. Also from lot 10 on Northwest corner of Block 137 to lot 16 on North East corner of Block 136. Also on East side of 3rd St from White Avenue to Oway Avenue. Also from Northwest corner of Block 115 to Northwest corner of Block 71 along East side of 7th St. Also from Southwest corner of Block Seventy one (71) to South East corner of Block 70, along the North side of Grand Avenue. Also from Southwest corner of Block 84 to the South East corner of Block 85 along the North side of White Avenue. Also in front of lots 1 & 32 Block 74. & front of lots 1 and 32 Block 59 and crossings. Also from Northwest corner of lot 1 Block 122 to lot 125 same Block.

On motion the yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result, Trustees voting were Adams yea Pardue yea Crosby yea, Hynes yea Walf yea

Resolved that in the opinion of the Board it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of the lots and Blocks described in the foregoing petitions. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance, except it be four feet wide, be constructed along and in front of said lots under the Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result Trustees voting were Pardue yea Crosby yea Walf yea Hynes yea.



Resolved that in the opinion of the Board it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed on the South side of Colorado Avenue from 2nd to 3rd Streets and on the East Side of 3rd St to Main St and on the South side of Main St to 4th Street. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance be constructed along and in front of the lots on said Streets under the ordinances concerning Sidewalks. Mr H R Rhone presented his resignation as Mayor which on motion was accepted.

On motion a Ballot was then taken for Mayor to fill the vacancy and Orson Adams Jr received four votes Trustees voting for were Crosby, Keynes, Pardue and Wolf.

Certificate of the Town Marshal and Acting St Commissioner on the cost of construction of sidewalks in front of certain lots was presented and approved and on motion the Recorder was instructed to draw a Warrant on the Treas to Dickie & Curvie in the sum of \$85 <sup>26</sup>/<sub>100</sub> in payment of same.

A communication was received from W L Reeve Pres of Water Co in relation to Water works and pipe which was read and on motion laid on the table.

Report of Treasurer for months of Nov & Dec presented and accepted. Also Report of Police Magistrate for Dec received and accepted.

Olsen Bros and Co filed a new Bond for the purpose of Retaining Reigors on lot 12 Block 123 for one year. which on motion was approved.

Bills of Dickie & Curvie for constructing sidewalks was presented. amount \$85 <sup>26</sup>/<sub>100</sub> which was on motion disallowed.

On motion the following Bills were allowed and ordered paid.

 Mr Reither appeared and requested permission to put  
 up a frame building & tent near corner of Wind and Main  
 Street. request granted.

The Committee appointed to draw plans and specifications  
 for Hose House presented same and were on motion  
 granted further time with power to act.
