Jan 24th 1890

entry appeared before the Board and requested affidavits
as to the following points.

- 1st as to the Municipal occupation of the land
- 2nd. Number of Inhabitants at time of entry was made
- 3rd. Extent and value of improvements at date of entry
- 4th. As to the official character and authority of the
officer making the entry.

Mr. Caswell attorney and B. K. Kennedy Marshal
were requested to have such affidavits prepared

The Bond of Mc Bride & Arman for construction and
completion of Hose House & Hall, was presented read
and on motion the yeas and nays called for on the approval
of same with instructions that the Mayor and Recorder
sign the Contract, with the following result. Trustees
voting were Welf yea Pardue yea Whitehead yea. Crosby
yea.

Motion made and carried that a Committee of
three be appointed to examine the foundation of Jail
and report at next meeting, Messrs Pardue Welf and
Heynes were appointed such Committee,

On motion the Marshal was instructed to
furnish Isaac Garnet with the necessary supplies
for his support.
