March 3rd 1890

Regular meeting of the Board at the City Clerks  
Office at 7<sup>30</sup> o'clock P.M.,

Present Orson Adams Jr Mayor and  
Trustees Brasley Pardue Wolf and Heynes,  
Minutes of last regular and Special meetings  
read and approved.

A Petition was presented for construction of  
a sidewalk from the alley between Ute and  
Pitkin Sts to main St on West side of both  
Sts. And on motion the yeas and nays were called  
for on the following resolution with the following  
result Trustees voting were Brasley yea Wolf yea  
Heynes yea Pardue yea.

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees  
it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed  
along and in front of lots 16 & 17 Block 117 and  
16 & 17 Blk 126 and 16 Blk 129. Therefore be it  
ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by  
Ordinance, <sup>except it be six feet wide</sup> be constructed along and in front of said  
lots under the ordinances concerning sidewalks.

A Petition to raise the sidewalk from the west  
side of lot 9 to the west side of lot 1 in Blk 119

was presented and on motion the prayer of the petitioners was granted,

A Petition was presented to raise Auctioneers license from \$25 per year to \$500 per year and on motion was referred to Town Atty with instructions to draw up an Ordinance to cover same,

Reports of Treas and Police Magistrate was presented and on motion approved,

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Granting a right of way to the Western Union Telegraph Company", with the following result. Trustees voting were Crosby yeas Pardue yeas Wolf yeas Keynes yeas. Ordinance declared passed and adopted.

The yeas and nays were also called for on the adoption of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance" The annual Appropriation Bill for the fiscal year beginning April 1st 1890 and ending March 31st 1891, with the following result Trustees voting for were Crosby yeas Pardue yeas Wolf yeas Keynes yeas. Ordinance declared passed and adopted.

An Ordinance for the protection of the Water Co and works was presented and referred to Town Atty,
