of Block 116 to North East corner lot 11 Blk 116  
was presented and the yeas and nays called  
for on the adoption of the following resolution with  
the following result Trustees voting were Crosby yea  
Wolf yea Keynes yea Pardue yea Whitehead yea

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees  
it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed  
along and in front of lots 11 to 20 inclusive in  
Block 116 Therefore ~~it~~ it is ordered that a sidewalk  
such as provided by ordinance except it be four  
feet wide be constructed along and in front of said

lots under the Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

Petition of Dan J Goff to transfer his retail liquor license to the firm of Goff & Fredericks corner of 5<sup>th</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sts was on Motion granted.

Petition to pay the Contractors on City Hall the loss sustained by the walls having been blown down was presented, on motion Petition referred to incoming Council

The yeas and nays were called for on the motion to disallow the Bills of Keoney & Howe, <sup>#100</sup> and Keoney & Rhone #168<sup>50</sup> for services in securing town Patent with the following result. Trustees voting were Crosby no Wolf no Keynes no Pardue yea Whitehead yea. Bills declared disallowed.
