

Graud Junction Colo
April 11th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment,

Present Mayor Bradish, and Trustees
Crosby, Canon, Miller, Dulmaine and Snyder
Minutes of last regular meeting read and
approved.

A Petition for laying water main on 4th
and 3rd Streets presented and referred to the
Water Committee. Also petition for water
main on Road between 4th and 5th Street
presented and referred to same Committee.

The petition for paying Contractors for
damage to lease house by wind was taken up
and on motion referred to a Special Committee
consisting of Crosby Canon and Dulmaine.

The Reports of Treas and Recorder
for year ending March 31st was referred to
Finance Committee.

A Ballot was then taken for Mayor
pro tem and Benton Canon received four votes
Trustees voting were Crosby Dulmaine Miller
and Snyder.

The yeas and nays were then called for
on the adoption of "An Ordinance amending Section
4 of Article 2 of Chapter III of the Revised
Ordinances of 1884", with the following result
Trustees voting for were Crosby yea Canon yea
Miller yea Dulmaine yea Snyder yea Hammond yea
Ordinance declared passed and adopted.

The Official Bonds of the Marshal,
Assistant Marshal and Street Commissioner were
approved.

On motion the Street Commissioner was
instructed to set out trees on both sides of

5th Street from Utter St to State Bridge

On motion the Street Commissioner was instructed to use the present pound until further notice and the matter of procuring a new pound site be referred to the Finance Committee.

On motion the Marshal was permitted to withdraw his Bond.

Motion made and carried that the Street Commissioner enforce all Ordinances in relation to cleaning the city.

Board then adjourned to April 15th at 3 o'clock Pm.
