

Grand Junction Colo
April 15th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 9 o'clock
P.M. Present Mayor Bradish and Trustees
Crosby, Canon, Hammond, Miller, Snyder and
Dulmaine. A Petition was presented requesting
the Board to order trees set out on 7th Street to
North Avenue. The petition was granted and so
ordered by the Board.

On motion the question of putting on a tin Roof
in place of corrugated Iron at Jail was
referred to the Special Committee on Jail.

The Official Bonds of Recorder, Treasurer
and Police Magistrate were approved.

On motion the Special Committee on Jail and
Hose house was empowered to employ a Competent
Builder to take charge of and superintend the
construction of the Jail & Hose house.

The Mayor then announced the following
committees for ensuing year.

On motion the opening of 6th and
7th Street to the River was referred to the
Committee on Streets and Alleys.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to draw a Warrant in a sum equivalent to \$275 cash in payment of Water for Irrigation for 1890.

Also Warrant to Geo A Crawford for \$300 and The Grand Valley Canal Company for \$100 in payment of water for Irrigation for 1888

A Ballot then taken for Town Printer and P A Leonard received 5 votes and Edwin Price one vote. Trustees voting were Crosby Dubmaine Canon Miller Snyder Hammond.

P A Leonard was declared elected Town Printer

On motion the Committee on Streets and Alleys was instructed to locate the Public Fountains and report to the Board for approval.

The yeas and nays were called for on the resolution to increase the Salary of Marshal to \$100 per month with the following result Trustees voting were Crosby yea Canon yea Miller yea Dubmaine yea Snyder yea Hammond no

Resolution passed and adopted

On motion the Bond of the Marshal was approved

On motion the Street Com was instructed to construct drops in the town Ditch or lateral.
