

Grand Junction Colo
May 6th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Trustees Canon Mayor Protem and Miller Snyder Dubmaine Brosby Hammond.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance concerning Plumbers and the tapping of water mains", with the following result Trustees voting were Canon yea Hammond yea Miller no Dubmaine yea Brosby no Snyder yea Ordinance declared passed and adopted.

The yeas and nays were also called for on the adoption of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance concerning Barber Shops," with the following result Trustees voting were Hammond yea Miller yea Dubmaine yea Snyder yea Brosby yea Canon yea. Ordinance passed and adopted.

Plats of Keith Addition and Capitol Hill subdivision were presented and referred to Town Attorney.

A petition was presented for new sidewalk on west side of 6th Street from north side of Chipeta Av to north side of Main St except along lot 16 Blk 73 and lot 16 Blk 104. Also petition presented for sidewalk on north side of Pitkin Av from 4th to 5th Sts.

Also petition for sidewalk on west side of 3rd St from South St to Main St.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result Trustees voting for were Hammond yea Miller yea Dubmaine yea Snyder yea Brosby yea Canon yea

Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of the lots described in said petitions. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by ordinance except it be four feet wide on 6th St. and six feet wide on Pitkin and six feet wide on west side of 3rd St from South St to Colorado Ave and 8 ft wide from Colorado Ave to Main St be constructed along and in front of said lots under the Ordinances concerning Sidewalks.

On motion the St Commissioner was instructed to open 3rd St to North Avenue.

On motion the question of conducting the waste water on 5th St to the west side of the water works plant was referred to Committee on Streets & alleys with power to act.

On motion the question of putting water into the hose house and jail was referred to the Committee on Fire with power to act,

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of An Ordinance Amending Sec 1 of Chapter 1 Revised Ordinances with the following result Trustees voting were Hammond yea Miller yea Dulmaine yea Crosby yea Snyder yea Canon yea. Ordinance passed and adopted.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of an Ordinance repealing Article 2 of Chapter XII entitled "Bell tax" with the following result Trustees voting were Hammond yea Miller yea Crosby yea Canon yea Dulmaine nay. Ordinance passed and adopted.

Also the yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of An Ordinance Amending Sec 2 of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance concerning Licenses" with the following result Trustees voting were Crosby no, Miller yea Dulmaine yea Snyder yea Hammond yea Canon yea. Ordinance passed and adopted.

Bill of Jas Lemmings \$17.50 referred to Finance Committee. Bill of Grand Junction Land & Investment Co laid on the table. Bill of H R Rhone \$168 ⁵⁵/₁₀₀ and Hovey & Howe \$100 referred to City atty as to legality of same.
