Regular meeting of the Board.

Present Union Mayor forstem and Trustees
Hammond Dubmaire, Miller and Snyder

Minutes of last regular and Special meetings
read and approved.

Reports of Treas and Recorder for fiscal year
ending Mch 31st. were reported on by the finance
Committee as being correct. Report accepted.

Monthly report of St Com and Police Magistrate
presented and approved.

Petition of Bremzer and Nichols for License
providing the amount was reduced to \$500 was presented
and referred to Committee on Licenses.

and on motion the matter was laid over.

On motion the Street Commissioner was
instructed to put Boxes in Rood and Main
Streets in Keith Addition and also to raise
the Boxes on South side of Main St at intersection
of 4th St.

The Committee on Streets and Alleys reported
they had located the Public fountains on
North west Corner of 3rd and Main Sts and 6th
and Main Sts.

The Petition for Water main on 4th Street
from Main to Rood thence to 5th St was taken
up and on motion the main ordered laid with Fire
Hydrant at North East corner of Rood and 4th St

Also on motion the Water main was ordered extended
from South Ave to Ute and from 3rd St to 4th St
on Pitkin and Fire Hydrant at North East corner
of Pitkin and 3rd Sts and North West corner of
Pitkin and 4th Sts.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption
of an Ordinance Concerning Barbers and last.

The matter of Insuring the Hose house and jail
was referred to the Committee on Fire.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to correspond
with the Railroad Company in relation to opening
6th St through their property.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption
of an Ordinance to regulate Plumbers which was
lost.

Board adjourned to May 6th at 2 o'clock PM
