

Grand Junction Colo  
May 7th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Trustees Canon Mayor Jackson  
and Crosby, Hammond, Dulmaire, Miller, and  
Snyder.

The committee on Licenses reported that they  
do not recommend the passage of an Ordinance to reduce  
the License for Retailing Liquors.

On motion the Report was adopted.

On motion Mr Dulmaire was appointed a Committee of  
one with power to Contract for Extra work on Hoese  
house, and also to put ~~in~~ water into the Building.

On motion the matter of lighting the City  
Hall was referred to the Committee on Fire with  
power to act.

Motion made and carried that the Fire Ins  
on City Hall be divided equally between the firms  
of Arthur P Cook & Co and Smith & Baldwin and  
that the Building be insured for the fullest amount  
possible.

x On motion the Water Committee was instructed  
to confer with Mr Kruseu Supt Water Co in  
regard to the fittering of the water.

Motion made and carried that the Hoese  
House and Jail be accepted as far as completed  
and the third payment of 25% of the Contract  
price be paid to Mc Bride & Trnman Contractors.

Board then adjourned to May 19th  
at 9 o'clock a m
