

Grand Junction Falls
May 19th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor protem Canon and trustees Miller Hammond, Dulmaine and Snyder.

Petition presented for sidewalk on East side of lot 17 Block 104 ^{between main and Bond Streets} and on motion the yeas and nays were called for on the following Resolution with the following result

Trustees voting were Miller, Hammond, Dulmaine and Snyder. "Whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it is necessary that a new sidewalk be built along and in front of lot 17 Block 104. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance except it be four feet wide be constructed in front of said lot under the Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

Petition of Mrs Nellie M Strasser wd for permission to let her tent remain on north west corner of 7th and main Sts was presented and on motion petition was laid over till next regular meeting.

Application and Bond of John S Dennis for Plumbers License was presented and Bond approved.

A Protest from the Water Company against Ordinance concerning Plumbers presented filed and on motion laid on table.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to draw a Warrant to pay Insurance premiums.

On motion the Marshal was instructed to have Jail Cells repaired.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance concerning Slaughter houses and other unwholesome and offensive business, with the following result - Trustees voting were Miller yea Hammond yea Dulmaine yea Snyder yea. Canon yea. Ordinance passed and adopted.

On motion Mr Payne was granted temporary permit to let his Slaughter House remain in its present location.

On motion the City Atty was instructed to draw up Deed for Court House Block.

The finance committee was instructed to confer with City Treas in regard to opening his Books. On motion the Com on Sts valleys instructed to confer with Co Coms in regard to opening 3rd St.
