June 9th 1890

Regular meeting of the Board

Present Mayor Bradish and Trustees Dubmaine Miller, Hammond and Canon.

Minutes of last regular and Special meetings read and approved.

A Petition was presented asking the Board to order the water shut off from north side of Main St between 5th and 6th Sts., and on motion the Street Commissioner was instructed to turn off the water from the Ditches on both sides of Main St between 3rd and 6th Streets.

Report of Treas for month of May and half month of April presented and referred to the Finance Committee.

Certificate of the Street Commissioner on the construction and cost of sidewalks in front of certain lots was presented read and approved and on motion the Recorder was instructed to draw a Warrant on the Street and alley fund to David E Nelson for \$49 $\frac{50}{100}$ in payment of the construction of the same.

The following resolution was then offered,
Resolved that a Special tax of \$7 $\frac{12\frac{1}{2}}{100}$ be and is hereby assessed against lot 14 in Block 98
and a Special tax of 7 $\frac{12\frac{1}{2}}{100}$ be and is hereby assessed against lot 15 in Block 98

The said amounts respectively being the cost of constructing sidewalks along and in front of said lots and parcels of ground respectively said work of construction having been done in compliance with the order of this Board and the ordinance in such case made and provided, the Board to meet on Monday June 23rd at 8 o'clock PM to hear and determine any and all complaints as to the justness of said sidewalk assessments.

 Hammond yeas Canon yeas. Ordinance declared passed
 and adopted.

Motion made and carried that the Finance Committee
 have power to act in taking lease on lots in Block
 125 from School Dist No 4 for a Pound.

Motion made and carried that the Lease House
 and Jail be accepted and the last payment on the
 same be made to McBride & Orman contractors.

On motion the Brass Band was granted
 permission to use the City Hall for practicing.
