Board met pursuant to adjournment,

Present Mayor Bradish and Trustees Leanon Brosky Miller, Hammond and Snyder.

No lot owners having appeared in response to the following notice which was duly published as required by ordinance

Notice to Certain Lot Owners.
 Public notice is hereby given to the owners of the following described lots, in the town of Grand Junction, Colo., that a tax, the amount as set opposite each of said lots respectively, has been certified and by the Board of Trustees of said town, assessed against each of the following described lots, to defray the cost of constructing side walks in front and along the sides thereof:

to make complaint. the assessment heretofore made against each of said lots was on motion confirmed, and the Recorder was instructed to certify said assessments to the County Clerk if not paid to him on or before the 10th day of July 1890 together with ten percent penalty.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adoption of the following Resolution with the following result Trustees voting were Miller yea Brosky yea Leanon yea Hammond yea Snyder yea

Whereas there has been erroneously paid out of the General Fund of the town of Grand Junction for the fiscal year ending March 31st 1891 the sum of \$5075.00 for the construction of the Town Hall and Jail which amount should have been paid out of the special Fund for Public Improvements the appropriation for which was made December 9th 1889. Therefore be it resolved that the sum of \$5075.00 be transferred from said Public Improvements Fund to the said General Fund.

Motion made and carried that all work on the streets except keeping crossings in repair be suspended unless authorized by the Council

or Mayor.

On motion the matter of making gutter in alley between Road & main and 5th & 6th Sts was referred to the Committee on Streets & Alleys.

On motion a warrant was ordered drawn for \$10 - to Jas W Buskirk in payment of costs in the case Rhone vs Town of Grand Junction.

On motion Mr Leanon was appointed a Committee of one to confer with Mr Rhone in relation to his Bill against the Town.
