on lot 21 Block 119 be removed, in accordance
with a petition presented asking its removal

Petitions were presented by J F McFarland for the "First National Bank" and G O Bunnell to erect Buildings on lots 17 & 18 in Block 103. on motion permits were granted to erect said buildings according to the plans and specifications.

On motion the Street Com was instructed to employ Mr Bailey to cut the brush on the Ditches and Streets.
