

Grand Junction, Colo.
August 12th 1890.

Board met pursuant to adjournment at 2 o'clock P.M.
Present Mayor Bradish, and Trustees Miller, Hammond,
Crosby and Snyder.

On motion the following resolution was adopted by the
following vote. Trustees voting were Miller yea, Hammond yea,
Crosby yea, and Snyder yea.

Resolved that the Plat of "Richard D. Mobley's First Sub-Division
to the Town of Grand Junction, Colorado" this day platted and
acknowledged, be approved and accepted as the official plat
of said portion of the Town of Grand Junction, Colorado.

On motion, R. A. Miller was granted permit to erect
corrugated iron buildings on the rear of Lots 29th and 30 in Block
104, in the Town of Grand Junction, Colo.

Motion made and carried that H. B. Freeman be granted
license to open an Intelligence office, in connection with his
brokers office without paying any further license fee than
is required for his brokers office.

On motion the Mayor appointed Trustees Miller and
Hammond to confer with the School Board of Dist. No. 1, and
with the County Commissioners concerning a proposition
to exchange titles to Blocks 84th and 95.

Board then on motion allowed the following bills.
