

Grand Junction Colorado
Sep 12th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor Bradish and Trustees Canon Crosby, Miller, Dulmaine and Hammond.

The yeas and nays being called for on the adoption of the following Resolution it was adopted. Trustees voting were Canon yea Crosby yea, Miller yea Dulmaine yea. Whereas it is the sense of this Board that the Street Car Company in laying their track up 2nd St to main instead of up 1st St to main as called for by their Franchise have sufficiently complied with the Franchise.

Bill of Grand Valley Canal Company \$33.40 was on motion disallowed. On motion the following Bills were allowed. Chris Pfeifer \$56.25, Mike Scheckenberger \$15.75 work on Sts. White and Mitchell Hardware \$12.

On motion the Street Commissioner and City Engineer were instructed to examine the alley between Rood St & main and 4th & 5th Sts and ascertain what is necessary to be done to drain the same.

On motion the St Joseph Catholic Fair were given permission to use the City Hall during the County Fair.

The Board received an invitation from Mesa Lodge No 55 A F & A M to be present at the laying of the Corner Stone of the School Building on Sep 27th which was accepted.

J H Ackerman asked for permit to erect a frame house on lots 4 & 5 Blk 126 which on motion was granted.

The Recorder was instructed to advertise for Bids to furnish the City with lumber to Jan 1st 1891 to be paid for in Town Warrants.

Board then adjourned to Sep 16th at 8 o'clock P M
