

Grand Junction Colo
Sep 16th 1890

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor pro tem Canon and Trustees Crosby
Dulmaine and Hammond,

Petition of Saloon keepers to reduce Saloon License
which was filed Sep 12th was taken upon the same
A petition of Citizens against Reducing the License
was presented and filed.

Petition to remove the boxing or fluming from
south side of Main St between 3rd and 4th was
presented and laid over.

Report of Treas for month of August presented and
on motion approved.

The yeas and nays were called for on the adaption of
the following Resolution and adopted by the following
vote. Trustees voting were Canon yea Crosby yea
Dulmaine yea Hammond yea.

Whereas: in the opinion of the Board of Trustees it
is necessary that a new sidewalk be built along and in
front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive in Block 139, and along and
in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive in Block 73, and along and
in front of lots 13 to 24 inclusive, and along the East of
lots 12 & 13 all in Block 121, and along and in front of
lots 1 to 16 and along the West side of lots 1 & 32 all
in Block 142; Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such
as provided by Ordinance except it be 10 ft wide on West side
and 6 ft wide on North side of Block 142, and 10 ft
wide in front of Block 121, and 4 ft wide on the north
side of Block 73, and 6 ft wide on North side of Block
139, be constructed along and in front of said lots
under Ordinances concerning Sidewalks.

Bond for Saloon License of F. W. Cobb was
presented and approved. J. B. Crawford and A. A. Miller
as securities. Applications for Janitor for City Hall
were received and on motion Albert Arman was
accepted and he was employed as Janitor for
one month at \$50 —
