Minutes of last regular, special and adjourned
meetings read and approved.

published as required by ordinance,

Public notice is hereby given to the owners of the following described lots in the town of Grand Junction, Colo., that a tax, the amount as set opposite of each of said lots respectively, has been certified and by the board of trustees of said town assessed against each of the following described lots respectively, to defray the cost of constructing sidewalks in front and along the sides thereof:

And that a meeting of the board of trustees of said town will be held at the council room in the town of Grand Junction on Monday the 8th day of December 1890, at 9 o'clock a. m. when and where the owners of said lots may appear and be heard as to the justness and correctness of the amount so certified and assessed against said lots.

The assessment heretofore made against each of said lots was on motion confirmed and the Recorder was instructed to certify said assessments to the County Clerk if not paid to him on or before the 29th day of December 1890, together with 10% penalty.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption of the following resolution and it was adopted by the following vote, Cannon ye Crosby ye
Snyder ye Miller ye Hammond ye Dulmaino ye
Thereas in the opinion of the Board it is necessary that a sidewalk be constructed along the West side and in front of lot 25 Block 98 therefore be it resolved that a new sidewalk such as provided by ordinance except it

be six feet wide instead of ten feet be constructed along the west side of said lot on the east side of 2nd St under the provisions of ordinances concerning sidewalks.

A Petition was presented for the construction of a sidewalk on the north side of main St from 7th to 8th St. The yeas and nays were then called on the adoption of the following resolution with the following result. Trustees voting were Cannon yea Crosby yea Snyder yea Miller yea Hammond yea Dubuaine yea.

Whereas in the opinion of the Board it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of lots 1, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, & 28 Block 106. Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as provided by ordinance except it be six feet wide instead of ten feet wide, be constructed along and in front of said lots under the provisions of Ordinances concerning sidewalks.

On motion the Street Commissioner was ordered to grade South Street near the Electric light plant under the order of the Mayor.
