Jan 12th 1891

Board met in regular session

Present Mayor Bradish and Trustees Canon Crosby, Hammond and Dulmaine.

Minutes of last regular and special meetings read and approved

Report of Police Magistrate received and approved.

Petition of John Shields to erect a frame Ice House on lot Block 101 presented and on motion petition granted.

Petition for sidewalk on north side of South Street between 4th and 5th Sts presented and filed.

The yeas and nays were then called for on adoption of following Resolution and it was adopted by the following vote

Trustees voting were Canon yea Crosby yea Hammond yea Dulmaine yea.

"Whereas in the opinion of the Board it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of lots 17 to 32 inclusive Block 147 and along and in front of lots 1 to 16 Block 147 town of Graud Junction

Therefore be it ordered that a new sidewalk such as provided by ordinance except it be four feet wide 2 inch plank laid on three stringers, plank to extend 2 inches on each side be constructed in front of said lots under the provisions of ordinances concerning sidewalks."

Petition to declare the Public Crawl on corner of 11th and 5th Sts a public nuisance was presented filed and referred to Town Atty.

On motion it was ordered that no more dirt from excavations for Buildings, be put upon the Streets unless by written permit from the Board.
