

Grand Junction Colo
Jan 19th 1891

Board met pursuant to adjournment,

Present Mayor Bradish and Trustees Canon
Crosby Miller. Hammond. Dulmaine and Snyder

The Petition to declare the Crevalls on Corner of 5th St
and Vite Ave a public nuisance was on motion laid over.

The Resolution adopted Dec 18th ordering a sidewalk
constructed on North side of Main St between 7th & 8th Sts
was on motion reconsidered by the following vote.

Trustees voting were Canon yea Crosby yea Miller yea
Dulmaine yea Hammond yea Snyder yea

On motion Snyder Miller and Crosby were appointed
a committee to confer with the Electric Light Co in regard
to lighting the streets.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to
advertise for Bids to clean the Sts Alleys and vacant
lots of the town within the following limits. from 1st
to 7th Sts from South St to Grand Avenue.

Bids to be received at next regular meeting.

The yeas and nays being called for on the adoption
of the following Resolution it was adopted Trustees
voting were Canon yea Crosby yea Miller yea
Hammond yea Dulmaine yea Snyder yea

"Whereas in the opinion of the Board it is
necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed in
front of lots 17 to 32 Block 73. Therefore be it ordered
that a sidewalk be constructed along and in front
of said lots, such as provided by ordinance except
it be 6 feet wide instead of 12 feet."

Board then adjourned
