

Grand Junction Colo.  
Feb 9th 1891

Regular meeting of the Board at 7 o'clock am.

Present J O Bradish Mayor and Trustees Cannon  
Miller, Snyder, Dubmaine and Hammond.

Minutes of last regular and Special meetings read and  
approved.

The S.A.R requested permission to use the Council  
Room twice a month for Post meetings which on motion  
was granted.

Report of Treas for Jan presented and referred to  
finance Committee.

The yeas and nays were then called for on the adoption  
of the following resolution and it was adopted by the  
following vote. Trustees voting were Cannon yea Miller yea  
Snyder yea, Dubmaine yea & Hammond yea.

"Whereas in the opinion of the Board it is necessary that a  
new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of lots 3-4  
40 Blk 83, lots 28 to 32 inclusive Blk 145, part of lot  
16 Blk 52 lots 3 & 4 Blk 73. Therefore be it ordered that  
a sidewalk such as provided by Ordinance except it be  
4 feet wide be constructed along and in front of said lots  
under the Ordinance concerning sidewalks.

Petition of R E Fletcher to erect frame building in Block  
101 was on motion not granted.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to notify  
the lumber dealers present to the Board proposals for  
furnishing the City with lumber to April 1st 91.
