Petition of Longgrove & Ryan to remove the Retail
Liquor business from lot 8 Block 118 and conduct
said business under their present license on lot 9
Block 118 was presented and on motion petition
was granted.

Resolution and it was passed by the following

Hammond yea Dulmair yea Miller yea Snyder yea.
Whereas in the opinion of the Board it is necessary
that a new sidewalk be constructed in front
of lot 17 & 18 Blk 104. Therefore be it ordered

that a sidewalk such as provided by ordinance be constructed along the East side of lot 17 and in front of said lots 17 & 18 Block 104 under the ordinances concerning sidewalks.

The yeas and nays were called for on a Resolution to employ J. S. McCann of Gunnison to make survey plat and estimates for a Sewerage system for the City, and that he be paid therefor a sum not to exceed \$250. The Resolution was passed by the following vote Trustees voting were Cannon yea Crosby yea Dulmaine yea Snyder yea Muller yea Hammond yea.
