

# Grand Junction Colo.

April 24<sup>th</sup> 1891

City Council met pursuant to adjournment

 were read and approved

M. J. Allison, Chairman of Committee on Streets & Alleys reported at length upon the condition of the streets and recommended many improvements. The report was adopted.

On motion bills of judges and clerks of elections were referred to the Finance committee. On motion bills for street work were allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the several amounts

On motion a warrant was ordered drawn in favor of the City Clerk to pay the annual water rent to the Grand River Ditch Company. On motion T. M. Buck was appointed a special policeman at the Depot to serve without pay

Finance Committee reported that they had examined the books of the outgoing City Clerk & City Treasurer and found them correct. On motion it was ordered that a list of all tools purchased for the Street Department be kept.

On motion all work or contracts of old board of Trustees not completed be and is hereby rescinded.

On motion City Attorney was ordered to draw an ordinance repealing License tax on vehicles. Mr. Bayes then appeared before the City Council, and asked that an appropriation of \$750.<sup>00</sup> be made for a fire tournament. The matter was referred to the Fire Committee
