

Grand Junction, Colorado May 26th, 1891
City Council met pursuant to adjournment.

Present: Mayor
L. M. Miller, and Aldermen E. W. Gannon, J. S. Hall
W. H. Lee, J. W. Norris. Geo. Ryan and D. P. Stetzelberger.

City Attorney, J. W. Bucklin, presented and read an ordinance creating a Board of Health. On motion the ordinance was adopted as read, the Aldermen voting as follows. E. W. Gannon, yea, J. S. Hall, yea, W. H. Lee, yea, J. W. Norris, yea, Geo. Ryan, yea, and D. P. Stetzelberger, yea. On motion the salary of the City Physician was fixed at \$40.⁰⁰ per month, Dr. A. R. Craig was nominated for City Physician. Geo. Ryan was appointed teller, and the following named Aldermen voting, E. W. Gannon, J. S. Hall, W. H. Lee, J. W. Norris, Geo. Ryan and D. P. Stetzelberger, and upon reading the ballots it was found that Dr. A. R. Craig had received the entire vote cast. When the Mayor, Declared, Dr. A. R. Craig duly elected City Physician.
