

Grand Junction Colo.

Aug. 14th A. D. 1891

City Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present: Mayor L. M. Miller, and Alderman M. J. Allison, C. C. Bower, E. W. Cannon, J. S. Hall, W. H. Lee, L. W. Norris, Geo. Ryan & D. P. Stetzelberger. An Ordinance granting a franchise for the construction, maintenance and operation of a street railway and right of way to The Grand Junction Street Railway Company its successors and assigns. Was read and adopted by the following vote, M. J. Allison yea C. C. Bower yea E. W. Cannon yea J. S. Hall yea W. H. Lee yea L. W. Norris yea Geo. Ryan yea and D. P. Stetzelberger yea. On motion it was ordered that the Street Car Company pay for the publication of the above ordinance

Finance committee reported that they had examined City Treas report for June and July, City Marshal report for June and Police Magistrate report for June and found them all correct.

Finance committee to whom had been referred a bill of

reported that the bill were correct; and on motion the bills were allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrants for the same.

D. P. Stetzelberger then introduced the following motion to wit: that \$1942.⁰⁷ Amount of money collected by County Treasurer for Hydrant rental for Water Company be paid in cash; provided the Water Co. accept the same as payment in full of all claims against the City of Grand Junction up to Feb. 7th A. D. 1891, and give a written receipt for same as payment in full up to said date. The motion was adopted by the following vote M. J. Allison No. C. C. Bower yea. E. W. Cannon yea J. S. Hall No. W. H. Lee No. L. W. Norris No. Geo. Ryan yea D. P. Stetzelberger yea and Mayor L. M. Miller yea.

A petition for opening of Main St. to the river was read, and on motion referred to the com. on Streets and Alleys

Reports of City Marshal and of Police Magistrate for month of July was referred to the Finance Com.

A motion was made and carried that the erection of a frame building 10x12 on lot 6 block 118 be not allowed.
