

Grand Junction, Colorado, Sept 21st 1891.

The City Council met pursuant to adjournment.

Present, Mayor L. M. Miller and Alderman C. C. Bower, E. W. Gammon, L. W. Norris, Geo. Ryan, D. P. Stetzelberger and W. H. Lee.

The claim of W^m F. Miller for street work for \$45⁰⁰ was allowed and the clerk was instructed to draw a warrant for the same.

A petition of George Pope for permission to erect a temporary shed was read and on motion was referred to the Committee on fire and water.

The City Council then listened to the reading of some of the revised ordinances as prepared by the City Attorney.

The Council then adjourned to Friday September 25th 1891 at 7:30 o'clock P.M.
