Grand Junction Colorado Oct 12" 1891 The City Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present Mayor L. M. Miller, Alderman C. C. Bower, J. G. Hall, M.H. Lee, L. M. Norris, Geo. Kyan and I. P. Dtetzelberger. The minutes for the regular meeting for Deptember 14th and Special meetings for Sept 21, Sept 25, and Sept 26 were read and approved The Finance committee reported that the reports of the city officers for the month of Deptember 1891 had been examined and found correct. also that the committee had let the contract for the publication of the ordinances to the Grand Junction Star it being the lowest bidder. On motion the report of the committee was accepted. The committee on streets and alleys was granted further time in the matter of the opening of Main street. a petition of T.D. Hunderson to erect a tent on the corner of Man and rifth streets was read and referred to the committee on fire and water. a petition of L.F. Gerhardt et al for a side ralk on the North side of Blocks 106 and 107 was read and referred to the commettee on streets and alleys. Job Payne presented a petition for a saloon on the South West corner of Block 142, corner of Second and Pitkin streets, which was read to the Committee on License. On motion the petition was allowed and the Clerk was instructed to issue a license upon the filing and approval of the proper bond. applications and bonds for saloon licenses over presented by Lesher & Crosby, Cosgrove and Ryan, Fredericks and Purcell, Fred H. Cobb and M.1. Devereux. On motion the bonds were all approved with the exception of that of M. T. Devereux which was referred to the Committee on License Ordinance No 22 bring an ordinance entitled "Un Ordinance ConOn motion it was ordered that the Street Commessioner be instruct

ed to at once shut the water of from the streets of the city. The resignation of Engene Bell as janitor of the City Hall was

presented and on motion was accepted

The matter of filling the vacancy caused by the resignation of the jantor was referred to the committee on fire and water with fower to act. The following sides were received for the publication of the wised Ordinances in book form.
