December 23rd A. D. 1891

City Council met in called session, City Marshal, Geo. K. Barton, filed written notice, that he had served notice of this special meeting upon each member of the ^{by reading same to them} City Council, except C. C. Hall, Geo. Ryan, D. P. Stetzelberger

Bill of S. J. Pub. Co. for \$327.⁵⁰ for the publication of the City ordinances was read, and on motion allowed, and the City Clerk instructed to draw warrant for same. Bill of S. J. Pub. Co. for \$42.⁰⁰ was reduced to \$12.⁵⁰ and on motion allowed, and City Clerk instructed to draw warrant for same. Bill of James W. Bucklin for \$355.⁰⁰ was reduced to \$250.⁰⁰ as per original contract for compiling & revising City ordinances, and on motion allowed, and City Clerk instructed to draw warrant for same.

Bill of White & Mitchell for \$7.⁵⁰ was read and on motion allowed and City Clerk instructed to draw a warrant for same.

Finance committee reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer, Police Judge, and City Clerk for month of Nov. and found same correct, on motion the report of said committee was adopted, and the reports of the officers ordered placed on file.

On motion City Clerk was instructed to transfer \$350.⁰⁰ from the Fire & Salary Fund to the General fund.

Committee on Fire & Water, made a report as to M. W. Keegan being allowed to erect a certain kind of building upon lot 27 block 102. A motion was made that the said Keegan be allowed to erect & maintain said building until the 1st of next May. Motion lost.
