City Council met in regular session. Present. Mayor L. W. Miller  
 Aldermen C. C. Bower, E. W. Gannon, W. H. Lee, J. S. Hall  
 L. W. Norris. Sec. Ryan & D. P. Stitzelberger.

Minutes of regular meeting held Jan. 12th A. D. 1892. were read and approved. The following resolution was then offered and on motion adopted. The yeas and nays having been called with the following result. C. C. Bower yea. E. W. Gannon yea. W. H. Lee yea. J. S. Hall yea. L. W. Norris yea. Sec. Ryan yea & D. P. Stitzelberger yea. Wherein in the opinion of a two thirds majority of the City Council, it is necessary that a new side walk be constructed in front of the the following described lots and parcels of land to-wit, The East side of lot 13 in Block 99; The East side of lots 12 & 13 in Block 100; The North side of lots one & two to 16, inclusive in Block 101; Therefore be it ordered that a side-walk such as described by ordinance, save and except that it shall be 4 feet wide, instead of 12 feet wide, and laid upon three stringers, be constructed along and in front of. The East side of lot 13 in Block 99; The East side of lots 12 & 13 in Block 100. The North side of lots 1 & 2 to 16 inclusive in Block 101. All of said walk to be constructed under the provision of the ordinance concerning Side-walks. The reports of City Marshal & Police Judges for Jan. were read and referred to finance com. B. F. Jay. City Clerk made a report for fiscal year up to Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> which was on motion adopted.

Finance com. reported that they had examined the reports of the City Marshal & Police Judges for Dec. and found them correct. On motion the report of the finance com. was adopted and the reports of said officers accepted and ordered filed.

Finance Com. reported and recommended the payment of A. J. McCune's bill for \$113.<sup>00</sup>. On motion the report of the com. was adopted, and the Clerk instructed to draw warrant for same.

Finance Com. read a cov. of bills of the Fire Department which had been referred to them, after some discussion. The City Clerk was instructed to draw warrant for \$100.<sup>00</sup> in favor of J. F. Byres, Chief of Fire Department to pay off all outstanding bills against the Fire Department. Provided the said Chief accept the same in payment in full of all outstanding indebtedness against the Fire Department.

Official Bond of John Dennis, as Plumber, was read and approved, and Clerk instructed to issue him a license as plumber.

Creon Adams & C. W. Steel appeared before the Council and asked that a side-walk 12 ft wide be ordered around Block 100 & 125. On motion the whole matter was referred to com. on streets and alleys with power to act. They also asked for two arch lights to be placed on corner of streets near New Opera House. The same was referred to com. on lights. They also asked for a check rate of License for the New Opera House. The same was referred to Com. on License.

Committee on lights, to whom had been referred, the petition of Geo. Wheeler et al. for Arch Light, reported adversely, unanimously.

Application for change of License, at Chamber Station, from Mr Cobb to Mr Darnell was referred back for correction. An motion bill of Mr Billings for \$2.25 for street work was laid on table.

Bill of Water Co. for six months ending February 7th. was read and lain over for the present. The following bills were read and on motion allowed and Clerk instructed to draw warrants for same to wit-
