

Grand Junction Colorado

March 8th A. D. 1892

City Council met in regular session. Present, Mayor
G. M. Miller. Alderman C. C. Bower E. W. Sannon W. H. Lee
J. G. Hall. L. W. Norris Geo. Ryan & D. P. Stetzelberger.

Minutes of regular meeting held February 9th A. D. 1892 were read
and approved. Several petitions were read, asking that gambling
within the City be prohibited, and that the saloons be closed on Sunday
Alderman W. H. Lee made a motion that the City Marshal be instructed
to enforce the City Ordinances on the subject of Gambling and Saloon closing
on Sundays. motion carried. Four petitions for new sidewalks
were read and referred to committee on streets and alleys

Finance committee, reported that they had examined the reports of
Police Judge, City Marshal and City Treasurer for month of January and
found them correct. on motion the report of the committee was adopted
Committee on Arch lights, reported adversely, and recommended
incandescent lights instead. on motion the report was adopted

An ordinance entitled "The annual appropriation
bill for the fiscal year beginning April 1st 1892 and ending March
31st 1893" was then put upon its passage, and passed and
adopted, by the following vote, ^{the following members were} C. C. Bower yea, E. W. Sannon yea
W. H. Lee yea J. G. Hall yea, L. W. Norris yea, Geo. Ryan yea and
D. P. Stetzelberger yea

An ordinance entitled an ordinance amending Ordinance No 11 of the revised ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, relative to salaries of City officers, and repealing Sec. 5. Article 3 of said ordinance No 11, was passed and adopted, The Aldermen voting were. C. C. Bower yea. E. W. Gannon yea. W. H. Lee yea. J. S. Hall yea. L. W. Norris yea George Ryan No D. P. Stetzelberger yea.

On motion City Clerk. was instructed to have published a notice relative to house numbering. On motion City Council adjourned until 7.30 o'clock P. M.
