

Grand Junction Colorado

July 12th A. D. 1892.

City Council met in regular session, Present Mayor L. M. Miller Aldermen C. C. Bower W. K. Lee J. S. Hall A. J. McCune M. L. Roberts D. P. Hyltberg A. R. Wadsworth & A. N. Anderson.

Minutes of regular meeting held June 14th 1892 and minutes of special meeting held June 21st 1892 were read and approved. A Petition for a side walk, signed by J. B. Crawford and others was read and referred to committee on Streets & Alleys.

Reports of City Treasurer, City Marshal and Police Magistrate for month of June were read and referred to Finance committee. Finance com. reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer, Police Magistrate and City Marshal for month of May and found same correct; on motion the report was adopted.

After some discussion the committee on Streets and Alleys were given further time to report upon the grading of Streets. Committee on health reported that they had purchased an instrument to test milk. Report of the committee was on motion adopted.

Committee on Streets and alleys was instructed to investigate the grades of side-walks on Main Street and report to the next meeting of the city council. Board of J. W. Cobb, for sale of

Lumber was read and approved. Bids for furnishing Lumber to the City for the ensuing year were read as follows. Rio Riv. #1895 per Thousand, S. P. Sutshall \$18.00 per Thousand, on motion the contract was awarded to S. P. Sutshall.

Mayor L. M. Miller called attention to the warrant of \$1666, that had been paid to the board of Penitentiary com. for the preliminary survey of the State Ditch, and on motion the City Clerk was instructed to call upon said Com. for an itemized statement of the expenditure of said money. On motion contract for City Pond was approved.

City Marshal was instructed to notify in writing all persons who had moved buildings from the present site of the Cannon Block, that the same must be moved within sixty days. On motion the City Clerk was instructed to correspond with the proper Rail Road official, and request them to remove their stock yards from the City Limits.

An ordinance on opera house license was read and referred to the City Attorney for revision.
