

# Grand Junction Colorado

January 13th A. D. 1893

City Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present Mayor  
L. M. Miller. W. H. Lee. J. G. Hall. M. L. Roberts. D. P. Stetzelberger  
A. R. Wadsworth & A. W. Anderson. The question of transferring  
the Saloon License of M. C. Darnell to Jacobs was discussed at  
length, but no action taken. The bill of J. M. Rumsey Mfg Co.  
of \$119.<sup>00</sup> for hose cart. was returned to the City by D. P. Stetzelberger  
the same having been O. K. by said company.

A Petition signed by the lady officers of the W. C. T. U., asking  
for the closing of Saloons on Sundays, and for the suppression of  
gambling, was read, and on motion of J. G. Hall the  
petition was granted, and the Marshal instructed to carry  
out the requirement of the petition. The putting in of  
Public City Scales, was discussed at length, and referred  
to a committee consisting of D. P. Stetzelberger, M. L. Roberts  
J. G. Hall.

On motion City Council adjourned to meet at  
7 o'clock P. M. Saturday Jan 14th. A. D. 1893
