

Grand Junction Colorado

January 10th A.D. 1898

City Council met in regular session. Present. Mayor  
E. Mc Miller Aldermen W. H. Lee, J. J. Hall  
A. J. Mc Cune, A. R. Wadsworth & A. W. Anderson  
Minutes of meetings held Dec. 13th & Dec. 16th were read  
and approved. A petition from the Academy of Science  
for deed to 50 ft of ground in the Court House block was read  
and referred to the Finance Committee and City Attorney

Reports of City officers for month of December were read  
and referred to the Finance com. Finance com. Reported  
that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer, City Marshal  
and Police Judge for month of November. Also the report of the City  
Treasurer for month of October, and the report of the City Surveyor  
in fixing grades on 5th Street; and found all of same correct.  
On motion thereport was adopted. Resignation of C. C. Bower  
as Alderman from the 4th Ward. was presented and accepted

Out of the \$500.<sup>00</sup> appropriated by the City for the entertainment  
of the Knight Templars. Mayor Miller returned to the City  
\$72.<sup>10</sup> Mayor Miller introduced a resolution of  
length to the effect that the State of Colorado should return  
to the City of Grand Junction the \$1500.<sup>00</sup> appropriated by the  
said City for preliminary survey of State Ditch, and that the  
City Clerk should forward a copy of the resolutions. To F. W. Smith  
State Senator and M. V. B. Page, representative, on motion  
the resolution was adopted. F. W. Cobb & Jo Dulmaine Bond for  
Saloon License, was read and approved. On Motion the  
City Marshal was instructed to close all Saloons at midnight

Mann & Mann made application for Telephone  
Franchise. Which was on motion referred to Finance Com,  
and City Attorney: The said parties were granted permission  
to erect a temporary Telephone line from Feed store to Pratt's office  
on opposite corner, On motion the City Clerk. was instructed  
from this day and date to draw Salary warrants from the General  
Fund instead of from the Salary Fund, By unanimous  
vote the street car Company were ordered to tear up their Street  
Car track from the Railway track, South to the Grand River  
Wagon Bridge
