City Council met pursuant to adjournment Present Mayor
L. M. Miller. Aldermen W. H. Lee J. S. Hall, A. J. McCarver
A. K. Wadsworth & A. N. Anderson Minutes of meetings held
Nov. 15th and Dec. 13th were read and approved.

Committee on License reported and recommended the transfer
of Wholesale Liquor License from Nellie Clark to Minnie Hazen
report of committee adopted and License ordered transferred.

Report of City Treasurer, City Marshal, and Police Magistrate for month
of November were read and referred to Finance committee

Also report of City Engineer was read and referred to Finance committee
Finance committee reported that they had examined the
reports of Police Magistrate, City Marshal for month of October and
found the same correct. On motion the report of the committee was
adopted. Finance Committee asked further time on City Treasurer
report for month of October. Further time was granted

A petition for sidewalk along Block 39 on 7th St.
Signed by J. A. Layton et al was on motion not allowed
A petition for sidewalk on 8th St. between Main St and
Wood Ave. Signed by Remy Bro et al was on motion not

allowed. A petition for Street Crossing signed by Geo. K. Lee et al was on motion not allowed

Block 77 signed by Walter Mulky et al. A petition for side-walk on North Side of was on motion allowed.

The following resolution was then offered and on motion adopted The yeas and nays having been called with the following result W. H. Lee yea. A. J. Hall yea. S. J. Milburn yea. A. K. Wadsworth yea. A. N. Anderson yea and Mayor L. M. Miller yea. namely,

Whereas in the opinion of a two-thirds majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new side-walk be constructed along and in front of the following described lots to-wit: On the North and in front of lots one (1) to sixteen (16) inclusive in Block 74,

On the South and in front of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 53

On the South side and in front of lot one (1) Block 115, and on the South and in front of lots 28, 27, 26 in Block 115,

Also on the North side of lots one to 12 inclusive in block 77.

Therefore be it ordered that a sidewalk such as described by ordinance save and except that it shall be four (4) feet wide instead of twelve (12) feet wide, and laid upon three stringers be constructed on the North and in front of lots one (1) to sixteen inclusive in Block 74, On the South and in front of lots 17 to 32 inclusive in Block 53. On the South side and in front of lot one (1) in Block 115, and on the South and in front of lots 28, 27, 26 in Block 115. Also on the North side of lots one (1) to 12 inclusive in Block 77. all of said side-walk to be constructed under the provision of the ordinance concerning side-walks

Bill of White & Mitchell of \$77.00 for two Hollaway Chemical Fire extinguishers was laid over until further test of the Fire extinguishers had been made,
