Nov. 15th A. D. 1892

City Council met pursuant to adjournment.

Present, Mayor L. M. Miller, Aldermen, D. P. Stetzelberger, A. R. Wadsworth, A. W. Anderson, A. J. McCune, W. H. Lee, and J. S. Hall. Minutes of meetings held Oct. 11th 12th, and Nov. 8th & 9th, were read and approved.

Official Bond of Charles W. Arnett, as Special Policeman was read and approved. Lease of Basement to City Hall Building was made to G. J. Casper & Co. from Nov. 1st 1892 to May 1st 1893, at \$12.⁰⁰ per month. A communication from M. Strouse was read, relative to the removal of a building of his own occupied by the California Restaurant, on motion said communication was laid upon the table. Finance committee reported that they had examined the reports of the City Treasurer, Police Magistrate, and City Marshal for month of Sept; and found them correct; on motion the report of the committee was adopted.

An application for a wholesale liquor license by Minnie Hays was on motion referred to the License committee.

The following sidewalk petitions was reported favorably upon by A. R. Wadsworth chairman of Street & Alley Com. to wit; one signed by J. A. Layton et al. and one signed by Chas. A. Hubbard et al. On motion the report was adopted.

On motion of D. P. Stetzelberger a cross-walk was ordered laid across 12th St; at Road Ave. Mr Stetzelberger also made a report for the committee on fire and Police recommending the purchase of two Holoway chemical fire extinguishers if they meet the satisfaction of council after a trial before the committee on fire & police.

City Treasurer, Police Magistrate and City Marshal made their reports for the month of October, which were read and referred to the Finance Com.
