City Council met in regular session. Present Mayor
 L. M. Miller W. H. Lee J. E. Hall D. P. Stetzelberger
 M. L. Roberts A. K. Wadsworth and A. N. Anderson.
 Minutes of Regular meeting held Sept 13th 1892, and minutes
 of adjourned meetings held Sept. 16th, Sept. 23rd + Sept.
 26th. A. D. 1892, were read and approved

Reports of City Treasurer & Police Judge were read for month
 of Sept. and referred to Finance Com. Report of Chief of Fire
 Department was read and on motion adopted. Report of
 City Marshal was read and referred back for correction
 Finance Committee reported that they had examined
 the report of the City Clerk, and the reports of City Treasurer
 City Marshal and Police Judge for month of Sept. and found
 same correct, on motion the report of the Committee was adopted

On motion C. W. Arnett was elected Special Policeman
 to serve at Depot, without pay from the City The question
 of rebate on Saloon License was on motion referred to the
 Finance Committee with power to act, On motion the

City Marshal was instructed to order Geo. A. Currie to
 take down the lumber roofing he had been putting up
 in his lumber-yard A certain building on lot 37 in
 block 119 was discussed as being a nuisance, and the
 same was referred to the committee on Health, Police & Fire with power
 to act

City Council proceeded to the election of a
 City Marshal with the following result: W. F. Miller one vote
 Fred W. Halbour two votes and M. F. Fredricks four votes,
 M. F. Fredricks having received a majority of all the votes cast was
 declared duly elected City Marshal. City Council then proceeded
 to the election of a Policeman with the following result:

W. F. Miller three votes and Fred W. Halbour 4 votes, Fred W.
 Halbour having received a majority of all the votes cast was
 declared duly elected Policeman. The following bills were
 read and allowed and the clerk instructed to draw warrants for
 the same.
