Sept. 26th A.D. 1892

City Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present Mayor
L. M. Miller, Aldermen C. C. Bower, W. H. Lee, J. G. Hall
A. J. McPune, M. L. Roberts, D. P. Stetelberger, A. R. Wadsworth
and A. N. Anderson. A report from the State board of Penitentiary
commissioners as to the expenditure of the \$1500.⁰⁰ received from
the City of Grand Junction for preliminary Survey of State Ditch
was read and ordered filed. A petition for Sidewalk signed
by M. L. Allison et al. was read and referred to the committee on
Streets and Alleys. Plat and survey of Sidewalk grade on Main
Street by D. R. Crosby City Engineer, was read and on motion
adopted. Charges preferred by Gene Bell against B. F. Reagan
City Marshall, were read and after hearing evidence from both
plaintiff and defendant, the charges were on motion sustained
and B. F. Reagan discharged from the services of the City as

Be it resolved. That for the purpose of defraying the expenses and liabilities, of the City of Grand Junction for the Fiscal year beginning April 1st 1892 and ending March 31st 1893 there be levied and collected on all taxable property real & personal within the limits of said City the following taxes on each dollar of valuation of such property to-wit

For the purpose of paying water rental on fire Hydrants three mills on the dollar of the total valuation of such property, and for all other purposes fifteen mills on the dollar of such valuation. The part of the above resolution
