

Grand Junction Colo.

February 21st A. D. 1893

City Council met pursuant to adjournment. Present Mayor L. M. Miller. Aldermen D. P. Stetzelberger J. S. Ball, W. H. Lee. A. J. Milburn. A. K. Wadsworth. A. W. Anderson J. J. Sharp. B. C. Smith. Finance Com. Reported adversely as to allowing "Academy of Science" fifty feet of certain lots near the Court house lots. On motion the report of the committee was accepted and adopted. Finance Committee reported and recommended the purchase of two "Holloway Fire extinguishers" of White & Mitchell at \$65.⁰⁰ On motion the report was accepted and adopted.

Finance committee reported adversely as to allowing Mann & Mann. A. "Telephone Franchise" On motion the Report of the Com. was accepted and adopted. Finance Committee Reported and recommended the purchase of City scales. They also stated that there were scales in the City that could be purchased for \$75.⁰⁰ On motion the report of the com. was accepted and adopted. The Sewer Question was called up and discussed at length, and referred to the Com. on streets and alleys for further investigation.

A memorial on State Ditch No two. was read by Henry R. Rhone, which was referred to Finance Com.

A petition for Sidewalk signed by Boyd C. Packer et al along blocks 141 and 124, were read and referred to Com. on Streets and Alleys. A bill for \$1⁵⁰ for Oscar Walker for use of leveler on streets was read and allowed and the Clerk instructed to draw warrant for the same.

On motion City Council adjourned until Feb. 28th at 7:30 P. M. A. D. 1893
